Guidance Notes

- (1) There is no need for licensees and relevant parties (such as wholesalers and agents selling games) to submit games, which are only for installation in Amusement Game Centres ("AGCs") for persons who have attained the age of 16 years ("Adult AGCs"), to the public officer appointed by the Secretary for Home and Youth Affairs ("appointed public officer") for vetting. Games installed in the Adult AGCs to be used or operated are subject to the existing legislation of Hong Kong. Licensees and relevant parties must ensure full compliance of the content of the games installed with the Control of Obscene and Indecent Articles Ordinance ("COIAO") (Cap. 390) and the Gambling Ordinance (Cap. 148). For installation of machines/devices with games that are indecent or have been classified as Class II (Indecent) under COIAO, please refer to the licence condition 10 and guidelines issued by the appointed public officer.
- (2) For the licence to be issued under Cap. 435, the applicant shall ensure that no act or activity on the licensed premises may constitute or is likely to cause the occurrence of an offence endangering national security under the Law of the People's Republic of China on Safeguarding National Security in the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region or other laws of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region.
- (3) The personal data provided by you on this application will be used for the following purposes:
 - (a) to facilitate assessment of the application for approval of amusement game device;
 - (b) to facilitate enforcement of the laws, regulations or conditions in respect of the licence; and
 - (c) to facilitate communication between Government and yourself on your application and other relevant licensing matters.

The form must be completed in full. If you do not provide sufficient information, we are unable to process your application.

- (4) The personal data you provide may be transferred to other Government bureaux and departments for the purposes mentioned in paragraph (3) above.

- (6) The Advisory Panel on Vetting of Amusement Games/Machines (comprising non-officials) assists the appointed public officer in the inspection of games/devices. The Panel meets on the <u>first</u> Friday (or the second Friday if the first Friday is a public holiday) of each month. Applicants are advised to submit their games/devices to the Office of the Licensing Authority (OLA) of the Home Affairs Department at least <u>three clear working days before</u> each inspection session. The decision of the appointed public officer on the games/devices will normally be given to the applicant within two weeks after the inspection session.

After completion of this form, you should submit it, together with the DVD which contains the full version of the game/device and relevant documents (*if applicable*), to the OLA by hand or by mail. You can also complete and submit the form via the electronic submission channel at https://eform.cefs.gov.hk/form/had088/en/. For submission of the form via electronic submission channel, you should submit the required DVD which contains the full version of the game/device and relevant documents (if applicable) with the transaction reference number quoted to the OLA by hand or by mail, within 7 working days after making the electronic submission.
- (8) Completed form may be submitted by an individual or a company representative. If the form is submitted by a company representative, it should be signed with the company chop. For enquiries on application procedures, please call the OLA at 2116 5230. Our facsimile is 2511 3860.

(9) Where necessary, a site inspection of the machine under application may be required and you should make necessary arrangements.
