Latest Directions by the Secretary for Food and Health published on 2 June 2020

The situation of COVID-19 outbreak in Hong Kong and the number of confirmed cases have slightly stabilised in the past month or so, but remain very volatile, with local cluster cases reported again recently. At the same time, the global situation remains severe.

- 2. In view of the latest epidemic situation, the Secretary for Food and Health published latest directions on 2 June 2020 under the Prevention and Control of Disease (Requirements and Directions)(Business and Premises) Regulation (Cap. 599F) which stated that among others, the existing regulations and restrictions on those amusement game centres under the definition stipulated in the Amusement Game Centres Ordinance (Cap. 435) will be maintained. The latest directions will be effective from 5 June 2020 to 18 June 2020, for a period of 14 days.

- 4. Since the epidemic situation could still fluctuate, special arrangements may have to be re-introduced at short notice.
